In our 34-bed PICU, our PICU nurses are trained to care for some of the sickest pediatric patients. Nurses choose to work in the unit because of the diverse patient population, high-acuity levels and the opportunity to continually learn.

Your shift is led by a charge nurse as well as a team leader that functions as a resource to the entire staff.

Our PICU team works closely with the CICU and the NICU, and often, our nurses float between the three intensive care units when additional help is needed.
